

# How is Edith Cavell Primary School accessible to children with SEND?

- We recognise that accessibility is not easy at Edith Cavell Primary as the school is built on many different levels but our [Accessibility Plan](#) sets out our aspiration to become more accessible. We are wheelchair accessible in 2 of our classrooms and our UKS2 block.
- We have audio enhancements in most classrooms to cater for children that are hearing impaired.
- There are disabled changing and toilet facilities located by the main entrance of the building and this includes a shower cubicle that can be easily accessed.
- We do of course, make reasonable adjustments in each classroom.
- We ensure, where ever possible, that equipment used is accessible to all children regardless of their needs.
- After school provision is accessible to all children including those with SEND.
- Extra curricular activities are accessible for children with SEND.
