## **Dear Parents**

Due to confirmed positive cases of Covid 19 in the school, it has been necessary for a number of staff to self isolate.

This means that we do not have sufficient staff within the Key Stage 1 bubble to safely operate and so all children in Emerald, Jade and Ruby classes, who had been attending school WILL NOT BE ABLE SCHOOL TO ATTEND FROM MONDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY to FRIDAY 15<sup>Th</sup> JANUARY.

We will review this situation throughout the week and will communicate further with you by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January about arrangements for week beginning Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

I can only apopogise that this is giving you less than a days notice of this change, but I hope you can appreciate how a situation can rapidly change which requires action at that point. This situation could not have been anticipated.

I am aware that your children have key worker status and so have taken up a key worker place to attend school, but I am unable to accommodate the children safely. I cannot move staff from other bubbles to support in KS1 and I cannot send KS1 children to other year groups for the safety and protection of the whole school community.

This is not a situation that we wanted to be in, but with the positive Covid case numbers rising nationally and especially within the Harpur Ward, where the school is situated, this is a situation that is occurring in many schools all around the country.

Children should continue to access home learning via Google classrooms, the printed learning pack, requested from the school office, or downloading the learning pack from the school web site.
