
Please look out for the latest edition of Digital Parenting coming home soon. It is full of tips about to support your children to be safe on line.

#### Administering medicines in school

Please can we remind parents of our policy around administering medicines in school. In the school prospectus it says

"Children must not be in possession of any medication themselves. If your child needs to take medication during school time, please see the school office so that procedures can be explained and an Indemnity Form signed. Medicines will only be given in school if they are prescribed by the doctor to be given 4 times daily. They must be handed to the office by an adult in the original container issued by the pharmacist and clearly labelled with the child's name. They must then be collected at the end of the school day by an adult."

This also means that children should not have cough sweets, lozenges or cold sore cream in their possession in school.

The school are not able to administer Calpol or other similar medication as these are unlikely to be prescribed by a doctor.

If you have any concerns about this policy, please contact the school office.

## School uniform

Please can we remind parents and children of expectations around school uniform.

Trainers are only permitted to be worn for PE lessons and are not to be worn outside that lesson.

While headbands are useful to keep hair out of children's eyes, they are not a fashion statement and so we would ask that headbands that hold large bows or cat ears are not worn for school.

Each of the UKS2 classes will have a PE lesson outside each week, therefore during the winter months PE kits should include track suits, long leggings or jogging bottoms. For outside lessons, Trainers are more suitable than plimsolls.

We would also like to remind parents and children that make up or facial cosmetics are not part of school uniform and should not be worn for school.

### **Shine Bright, Wear Bright**

4<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> February is the national Children's mental health week and to support our local children's mental health charity CHUMS, we are holding a non-uniform day on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February. The theme is Shine Bright, Wear Bright, so we ask children to wear bright clothing and make a donation of £1 which will be forwarded on to CHUMS.



## <u>Sponsored Event – Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February – Sponsored Bounce – Bounce for</u> Books



As our annual sponsored event this year we have decided to revisit an old favourite – A Sponsored Bounce.

We are looking to raise funds this year to update and extend our reading book collection. We want to ensure that the stock of reading books that the children have access to offers extended choice, is up to date and exciting for the children to read. ## Winter clothing

During the winter months we very much want children to wearing appropriate clothing for the weather and so hats, gloves, and scarves are an essential. Please can hats, scarves and gloves be named so that when they have been dropped in the cloakroom there is a chance or returning them to their rightful owners as younger children do not always recognise them as their own when asked.



#### Parking Reminder



A polite reminder again please that if you are parking on the residential roads around school that you ensure that you park considerately and do not block anyone's drive or access to their home.

I would also ask parents to stop parking on the grass verges on Manton Lane and then crossing the very busy traffic to collect children from school.

School has again received complaints that parents have been blocking access to a driveway and that the grass verges are being severely damaged by parents parking. This behaviour does not reflect well on the school and we would ask that parents ensure they arrive in plenty of time to bring or collect their children to school and possibly park further away and then walk into school.


#### **Attendance**


