

Who are the other people providing services to children with SEND in this school?

- **School provision**
- Every member of staff here at Edith Cavell has a responsibility to meet the needs of SEND learners.
- Teachers are responsible for teaching SEND groups/individuals through quality first teaching. Teaching Assistants mainly work inclusively within the class and lead measured interventions either in the classroom environment or Intervention Room with either individual children or small groups.
- ICT support such as education software and Autism Friendly symbols and is offered to aid children's learning depending on their need.
- The school's Learning Mentor offers emotional and pastoral support for children with emotional, social and mental health development through small group or 1:1 work.
