Christmas Cards

We are coming to that time of the year when the children are getting excited and ready to send cards to all their friends.

The children have had to adapt to so many changes this year and we know how important it is for the children to continue with the fun of Christmas. We have decided to still carry on the tradition of giving cards but with a few little changes.

This year, each bubble will have a letter box and the children will be able to post cards to the children in **their bubble only**. Please do not 'post' any cards to children **NOT** in your bubble.

To close the envelope, please remember to tuck the flap in and not stick the envelope down.

Please write the name and class clearly on the envelope.

The 'postbox' will be emptied on a Tuesday, the cards stored for 48 hours before sorting, and will be given out at the end of the day on a Friday. This means that the last day of 'posting' will be Tuesday 15th December. Any cards posted after this time will not be accepted.

Christmas Parties

Where we would normally ask parents for donations of food to be able to have Christmas Parties, this is not going to be possible this year. We **were** going to ask for a donation of £1 per child so the school can purchase appropriate party food for the children to enjoy.

However, The Friends of Edith Cavell have offered to pay for Christmas Parties for the whole school this year. This means that **NO parents** will have to make donations of food or money and the school will purchase suitably individually wrapped party food items that can be quarantined in school for 48 hours prior to consumption.

The children will maintain their bubbles and will not mix with other bubbles in the school.

The Christmas parties will take place within the last week of the school term.
