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Get Epic!

We are always striving to ensure all children leave Edith Cavell Primary being able to read confidently. Reading is our top priority. We regularly check that children are reading at home. We believe that reading at home regularly contributes greatly to the children's reading success. Research clearly indicates that those children who read at home become more proficient and fluent readers, and standards in other subjects are clearly supported by this skill.



For Years 1 - 6, to support children's reading at home, we are going to be using a website called **Get Epic** which has a large range of high quality, levelled books. <https://www.getepic.com/>

- Each week your child's teacher will assign your child a new reading book, set at their level and targeted to meet your individual child's needs. The child must read the book throughout the week.
- Once your child has read the book, they will be able to explore and listen to other books on the website.
- Your child will only be able to access the books **from 7am – 4pm, Monday to Friday**.

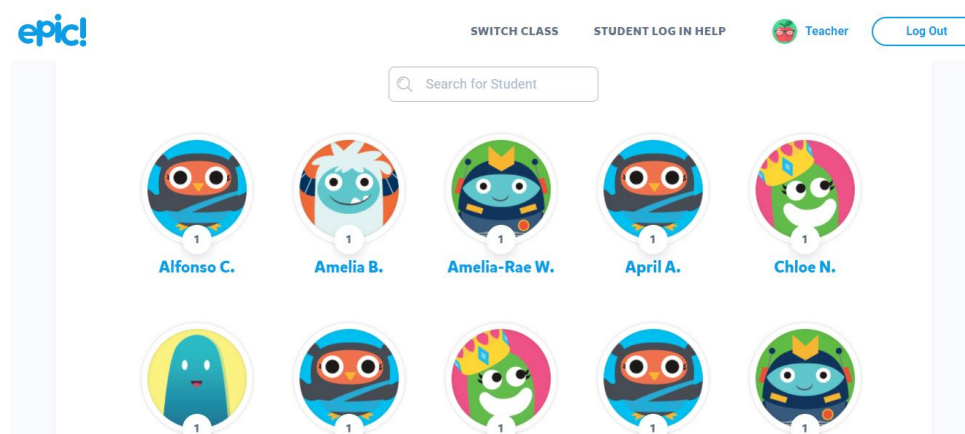
Get Epic Child User Guide

1. Go to www.getepic.com/students and type in your class code, which will be placed on Google Classroom for you.
