A message from Miss Cooke

An update on the removal of the layby on Manton Lane. After complaining vociferously to many people at the local authority, from the Mayor to Education staff and highways staff, eventually someone responded to my letters, emails and complaints and came out and met with me on Manton Lane to discuss the parking issue. The upshot of that meeting is that the school should have been consulted before any changes were made to the parking restrictions in the layby outside the school. The action that I was promised would take place is that following another consultation, part of the layby for short-term parking will be reinstated, hopefully sometime over the summer holidays and to be ready for the start of the new school year in September. If this does not happen I have the contact of the member of the local authority who met with me and said that this will happen.

This performance will take place at 6.30pm on Wednesday 13th July. We ask that only parents attend this concert. The Year 6 children will perform to the rest of school earlier in the day. Children in Year 6 should return to school by 6pm on that day ready for the performance to start at 6.30pm.

The concert will take place in the school hall and will start at 2.30pm.

Accelerated Reading

ccelerated In previous newsletters, we have informed parents that we will be changing the way in which we organise our reading scheme. We are moving to a new system called Accelerated Reader, where the KS2 children specifically, will read books

that are organised in a numerical form. (ZPD) This means that we are moving away from the coloured book bands. Children in Reception and KS1 will read books that are specifically matched to their phonics abilities and learning.

We have purchased a whole range of new reading books to support the move to Accelerated Reader, but to enable us to complete the move to the new system, most children will stop bringing home reading books after Friday 8th July. Some children will still be given reading books to bring home after this date, but for most, we would ask that parents still listen to their children read each day using books that they have at home. If families have a limited number of books at home, please consider joining the Bedford Library, where multiple books can be borrowed for free.

We will provide more information to parents about how Accelerated Reader works in September.

Ordering New Uniform for September

If you are considering purchasing new school sweatshirts or cardigans for the start of the new term in September, please use the Parent Pay Shop on the school website. You do not require a Parent Pay log-in for this feature, it can be accessed directly from the school website and you use a credit or debit card to pay directly for what you order. https://www.edithcavellprimary.co.uk/parent-pay/

When you order online in this way, the items can then be collected from the school office or sent home with your child.

Please ensure that you put your child's name in any new school wear so it can be returned to them if it becomes lost.

If any family find that their children have grown out of parts of their school uniform, we would be very happy to receive donations if it still is in good condition and can't be passed on to younger siblings.

We often support families who join our school, with good quality second hand uniform and are always looking to replenish our stock. So as the end of the year is approaching, and you are considering kitting out your children for the new school year, please consider if you could donate any outgrown uniform that is still in good condition.

<u>Final Day of term – Thursday 21st July</u>

We would like to give parents the opportunity to collect their children early on the afternoon of the last day of term, Thursday 21st July 2022. Children may be collected at **1.45pm**.

Any child may stay in school until the normal end of the school day if parents are working or they do not wish to collect them early.

We will forward a link to parents to indicate if they wish to collect their child/ren early on the last day of term or if they give permission for their Y5 or 6 children to walk home independently. This link will be sent out in the week commencing 11th July 2022.

Please note: Year 5 and Year 6 children will not be allowed to leave early without the school receiving a completed form from parents.

Parents may collect their child/ren at the early finish time from their normal class. Any children not collected at the early finish time will be cared for in their phase groups until the normal end of day.

There will be just two points at which children may be collected or dismissed, either the early finish time **or** at the normal end of day from their collection/dismissal point listed – **not** at any other time.

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<u> GEMS – Afterschool Club</u>

The after-school club will be available <u>until 4.30pm on Thursday 21st July 2022</u> and bookings should be made in the normal way via Parent Pay.
