A message from Miss Cooke

This has been a short but incredibly busy half term and so the half term holiday fast approaching is welcome to the children and staff. School will close on Friday 27th May and will reopen on Monday 6th June 2022.

I am aware that the removal of the layby on Manton Lane, two weeks ago, has been causing many parents a problem when picking up and dropping off to school. The school were not informed or consulted that this change of road usage was going to happen before it happened. I have tried repeatedly and am still trying to make contact with someone at Bedford Borough Highways to try to understand why this change of road usage has been introduced and find out if it can be changed back to a layby. I have included the local councillor, the Mayor as well as officers in the Highways team in my quest to have an answer to my questions, but as yet I have not had any response. I will keep trying.

Although the layby is not available to parents for parking, the staff car park MUST NOT be used by parents at ANY point in the school day. The staff car park is only to be used by staff and visitors to the school. Parents should consider parking further away from school and walking the last part of their journey to the school. This is advised as it reduced car fumes close to the school and also is a healthy option for parents and children to walk each day.

Platinum Jubilee Day



As part of the school's celebration of Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee, we will be holding celebrations in school on **Friday 27**th **May 2022**.

On that day, we are asking that the children come to school, 'dressed to impress' this could be in formal wear, fancy dress, party clothes, or in culturally traditional dress.

The children will take part in Jubilee celebration activities during the morning and at lunchtime the whole school will have a Jubilee picnic on the field.

To mark this unique landmark for the country and Queen Elizabeth, each phase of the school has been learning about a different decade of The Queen's reign and the dance styles that characterise that decade.

We are inviting parents to come into school and watch the children perform their Jubilee dances from 2pm on the school field. The children will sit around the three sides of the patio on the field and parents are invited to sit or stand behind the rows of children.

If the weather forecast changes to predict rain, we will have to cancel the outside performance and move to indoor performances and unfortunately, it will not be possible for parents to attend indoor performances. We will advise parents via text message before 11am if they will no longer be able to attend the performances at 2pm.

Friday Classroom reading with parents

Thank you to all the parents who have started to come in on a Friday morning to share a book with their children. You are demonstrating to the children the importance of reading and your support of their reading. We are aware that it is not possible for all parents to come into school on a Friday morning due to other commitments, but wish to extend that invitation to all for any occasion it does work with your schedule. We look forward to seeing any parents between 8.45am and 8.55am on a Friday morning.



PE Kit



As we move further into the summer term, it is possible for more PE lessons to take place outside. It is important to ensure that children have the correct PE kit in school – **including correctly fitting plimsolls or trainers**. We are finding that many children do not have the correct footwear to enable them to safely take part in PE lessons.

Part of changing for PE lessons is that all jewellery including earrings should be removed. Please ensure that if your child is wearing earrings for school, they are able to remove those earrings themselves, or parents remove the earrings at home on days that PE takes place.

Sun Safety



As the summer term progresses we are seeing some increasingly sunny and warm days. In order for children to be safe in the sun, we ask that parents apply sun cream to their children before they come to school in the morning, but also that each child has a **named** sun hat



available that they can wear when out in the sun for lessons as well as playtimes. Also it is important that children have a water bottle available every day so that they can drink throughout the day and especially when they have been running around at playtimes.

Parking on Turner Way and Kneller Close

We again respectfully ask that parents observe the Highway Code, road markings and respect our neighbours when parking to collect or drop off children to school. We are aware that the pressure on the roads surrounding the school has increased with the removal of the layby on Manton Lane and are trying to make representation to Bedford Borough to relook at the parking situation around the school.



Every driver is responsible for ensuring that when they park they obey road markings, road signage and show consideration for the residents of the street on which they are parking. Inconsiderate parking on local roads paints the school in a bad light with local residents and tarnishes the schools' good reputation in the local community and I would strongly urge every driver to examine their own behaviours and consider parking further away and walking in to school.
