A message from Miss Cooke

A little belated, but welcome back to the Summer term. There is lots going on in school this term and before we know it we will be at the end of July and the school year!

Firstly, I want to share some good news with you. Miss Martin gave birth to her daughter Elodie Mae on Tuesday 4th April 2023. Both Miss Martin and Elodie Mae are doing well and Miss Martin is enjoying getting to know her beautiful daughter.

I have been contacted again by residents of Knellor Close, concerned about parents parking on the DO NOT PARK sign, across drive ways and just stopping in the middle of the road to let children climb out of the car. My concerns are, that as well as the possible dangerous situations for children, parents and carers, that when myself, parking attendants or council representatives are in attendance on Knellor Close, parents change their parking habits and in the main park in accordance with the Highway Code. If parents can park correctly when someone is watching, why can they not do so every day? I urge parents and carers to please think about what this is demonstrating to your children. That it is OK to obey some laws/rules sometimes, when someone is watching, but you don't have to when someone is not watching. Is this the message that you want to be giving to your children?

I am aware that parking attendants have been patrolling on the morning of Thursday 27th April and that residents, parents and the school have been in touch with Bedford parking services to ask them to increase the frequency of patrols around our school.

I hope that families are able to enjoy the upcoming two bank holidays and that the weather improves to enable families to enjoy spending time outdoors.

PLEASE remember that school will be closed on Monday 1st May 2023 and Monday 8th May 2023 for the two bank holidays.




