Message from Miss Cooke

When we change the clocks in October, it always makes it seem as if winter is really taking hold and this year has been no different. With the amount of rain that we have been having over the past few weeks the need for good coats and shoes cannot be underestimated. Please ensure that your child has their coat, preferably with a hood, in school with them every day and wears correct school shoes. If the weather is poor and children are wearing wellies or boots to come to school, please ensure that they have their school shoes with them so they do not stay in their wellies all day.

Over half term, some parents may have received a letter, via email, asking them to pay dinner money debts and then saying that unless the debt was paid they would not be able to access breakfast and after school clubs. This letter was sent by Caterlink, our catering school meal provider, and **not** the school. While the debt that was quoted in the letter does have to be paid, the Caterlink staff had selected and sent an incorrect template letter and so I can only apologise if the tone of the letter as well as the content caused any concern or upset. We are working with Caterlink to ensure that communication is clear and accurate going forward.

Parent Consultation meetings have been arranged for next week, and these are a **VITAL** communication tool where parents can discuss how their child is progressing at school. For any child to be successful and fulfil their true potential it is **ESSENTIAL** that there is good communication between home and school. These focused 10-minute meetings enable dialogue around how home and school can work together to support **your** child with their learning journey.

ALL PARENTS MUST BOOK A CONSULATION APPOINTMENT WITH THEIR CHILD'S CLASS TEACHER.

If parents have appointments, before the end of the school day, they may collect all their children early. If parents have made appointments after 3.30pm, they must collect their children before attending their planned consultation meeting.

During half-term week we had an exciting visit from Fun & Active Playgrounds who came to install some new playground markings for our outdoor play area. We now help an abundance of educational markings to help with maths and English including a colourful number grid, number ladder, and learning clock, plus an alphabet snake, and a phonics pond!

It's been great to see the children enjoying their new playground games and we're pleased to have been able to introduce more opportunities for physical activity at our school, encouraging our children to get their recommended daily exercise.







We are coming into a very busy period in school with many different events that parents can attend in school. We look forward to welcoming as many of you as possible at the different events. If a parent can't attend due to work commitments, we are always very happy to see grandparents or different family members coming to support the children. Please note if it is a grandparent or other family member is attending the school event, they will not be able to take the child home, unless parents have given specific permission by speaking to the class teacher or office **before** the event.

Attendance at school

Edith Cavell Primary School is committed to giving our pupils the best education available. This is why we want to highlight to all parents the link between good attendance and education achievement. Our aim is to promote regular attendance and good punctuality in order to ensure all students achieve their full potential.

- 90% attendance= ½ day missed every week (Would your boss like you to be off work so much?) That's practically part-time!
- Absent half a day every week
- 1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons MISSED!!!

Attendance Matters Every Day Counts....

Your child **MUST** be in school on time every day.

- If they are not in school, they are not learning.
- 1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons MISSED !!!
- Poor or patchy attendance can cause gaps in knowledge and understanding and so hinder future learning.
- Only grant days at home for genuine illness (you will know!) Send them to school and if they are really ill we will send them home.
- Miracle Recovery—If your child improves after the school day has started we are happy for you to bring them into school at any time during the day.
- **Phone School** as soon as possible as to the reason why your child is absent from school and when you expect them to return to school or we will phone you later to follow up.
- Putting the school number in your phone, it will save you time.
- Avoid Medical/Dental Appointments in term time where possible—book well in advance
- Know the routine of the day to avoid issues e.g. have they got their PE kit and everything they need for the day
- Concerns for the day if your child is worried about coming to school for any reasons talk to a member of staff and we will try and help
- Avoid taking holidays in term time they will not be authorised.

Holidays in Term Time

- No requests for holidays in term time will be approved.
- Leave of absence, for up to ten school sessions (5 days), may be granted in exceptional circumstance, but not for a holiday.
- Any requests for leave of absence must be made in advance of the requested leave of absence. If the child has poor attendance, the child is often late for school, the request is around assessment periods or it is a second request, the request will not be authorised.

Non Uniform Day – Friday 10th November

We are inviting the children to wear their own clothes to school on Friday, in exchange for bringing a donation for the Christmas Fair. Donations such as a bottle for Miss Cooke's bottle stall, some chocolate that can be included on the chocolate tombola or a Jam Jar filled with a treat, such as sweets, bath salts or lego! The alternative is to make a donation of £1.
