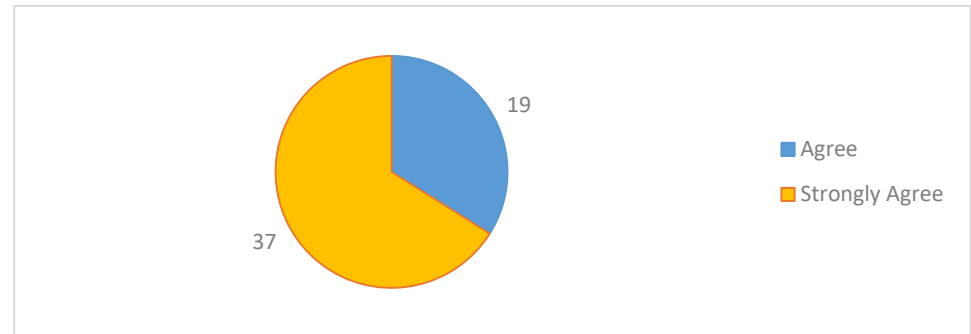

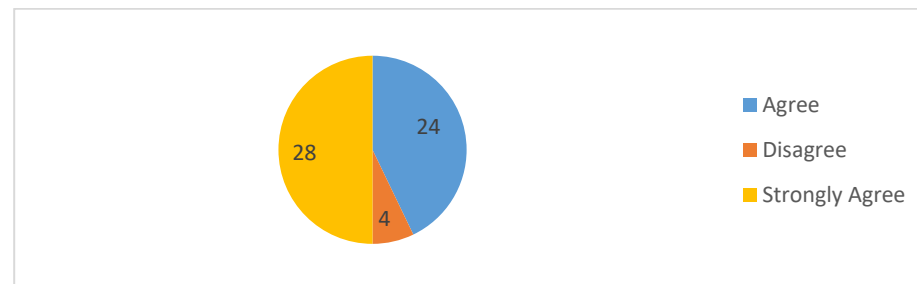

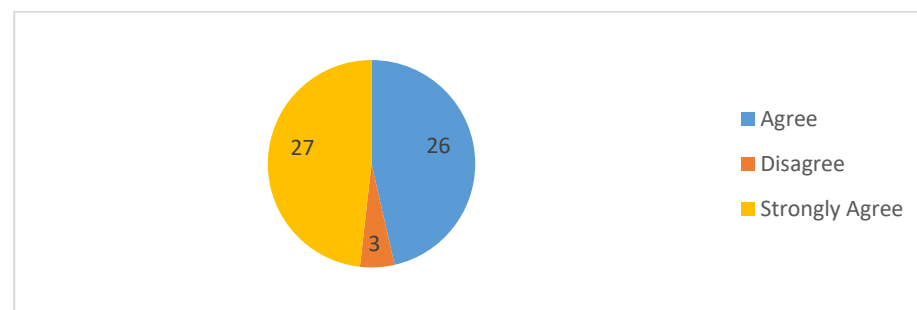

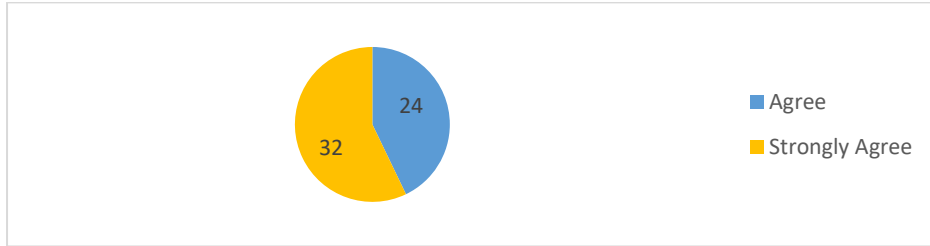

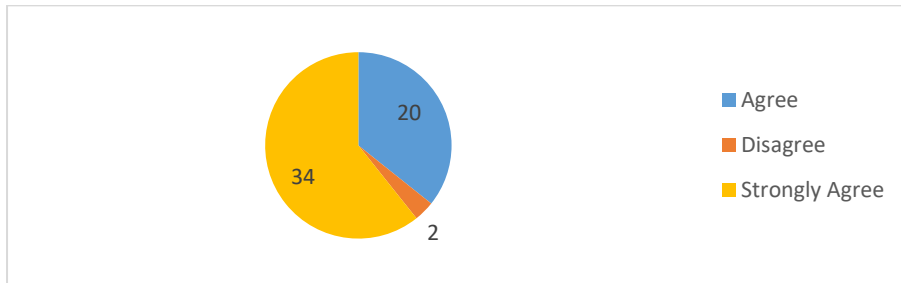

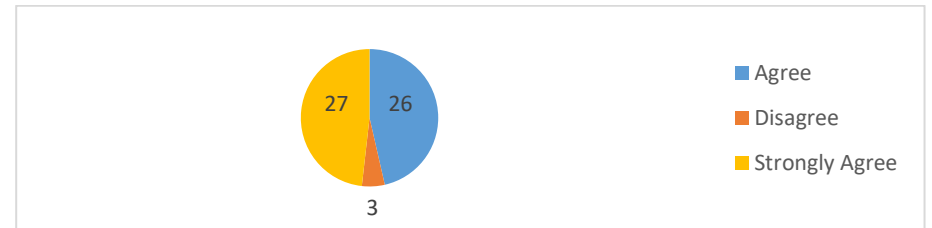

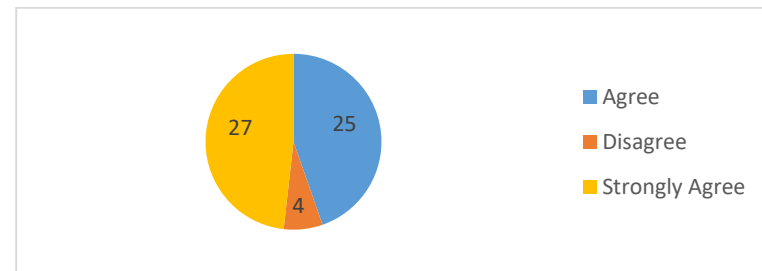

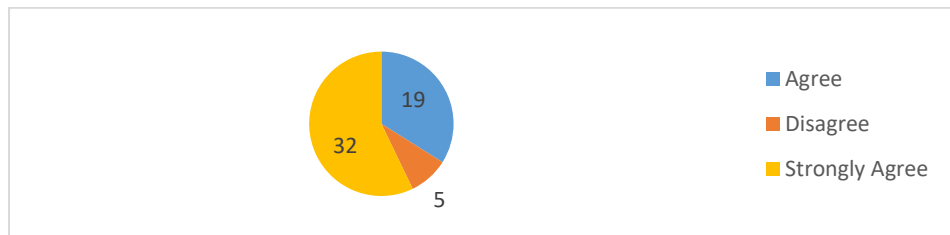

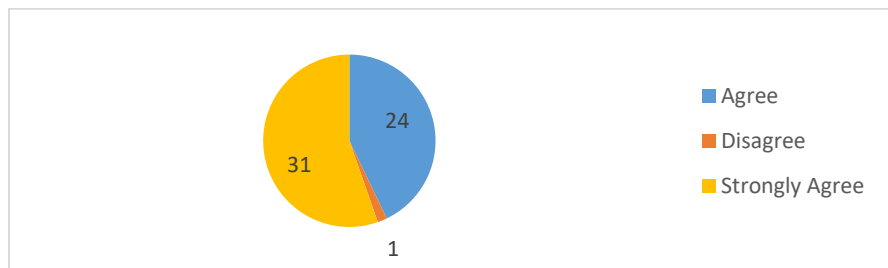

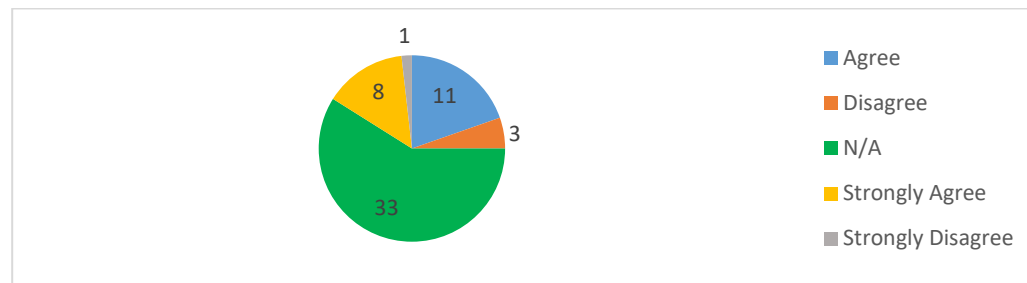

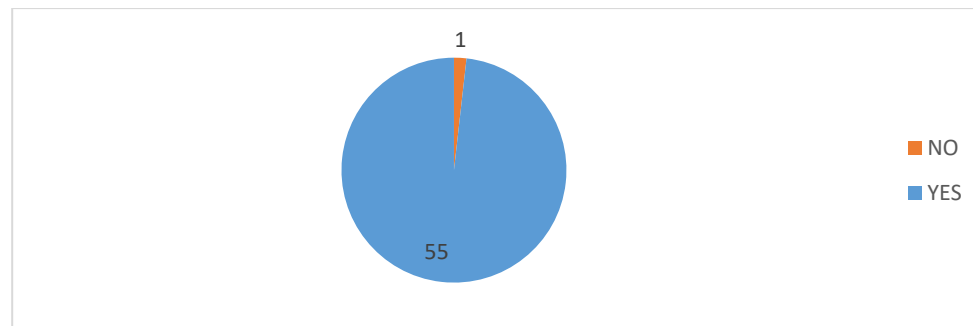

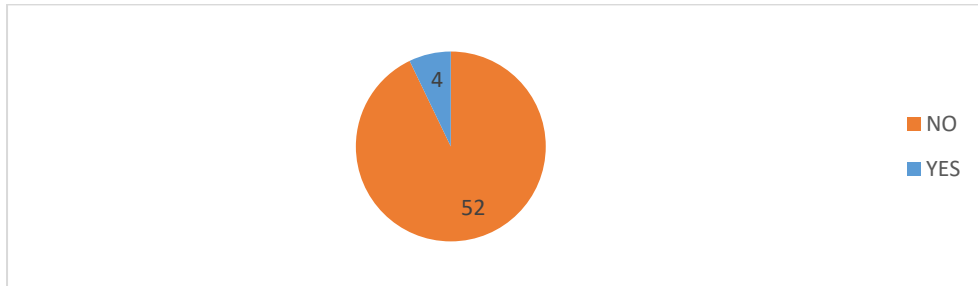

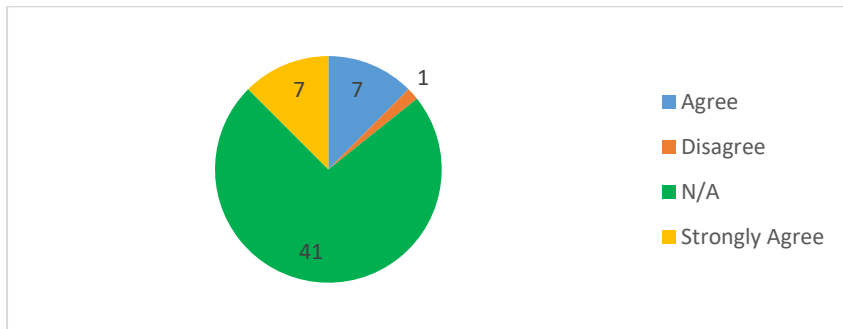

Areas parents would like the school to improve

Personally I would like more information on what my child will be learning on a term by term basis. In depth knowledge on subject content, pathways to progression and how parents could further support their children would be great. I would like to work more closely with our child's teachers on a regular basis to help our child achieve the best results in class.

I would also like to see more sports being played/promoted at school.

From what I know from my child, PE appears to be a random assortment of activities, rather than a focused attempt at improving children in any particular sport/area. For example: a rotation of sports, (such as the UK's top 5 - football, cricket, rugby, some form of tennis eg. Table or squash, basketball/ netball) climbing and perhaps self defense or combat would be great to see. My child seems quite underwhelmed and not challenged much in this area.

Would also like to see more healthy food options offered in the canteen.

Occasional confusion in communication home e.g. availability of lunch or timeliness of communication home e.g. fancy dress days (fire of London day as an example, had half term to inform parents but email was sent out after the week off, with one weekend to source an appropriate outfit - would have preferred more time in an ideal world!). However, always willing to clear up confusion without issue when asked.

More/varied school trips. Involve parents more. Let parents know what they are learning about in other subjects not just English and maths.

Please always send messages to parents when they come to drop off or pick up their child(re) not to smoke in and around the school. This can be dangerous for passive inhalers who are not smokers and who may have health conditions that may be triggered by inhaling the smoke. Thank you

Also there's little chance for parents to interact/form relationships and I find it quite unfriendly at times!
